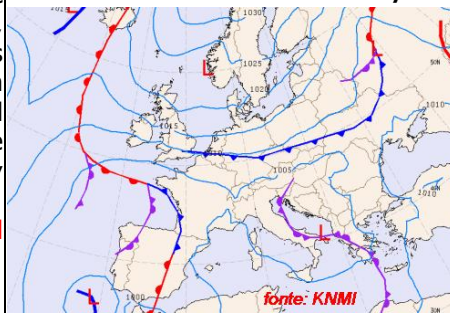


GENERAL CONDITIONS: A wide low-pressure area over the Baltic countries will gradually influence the weather in the Venetian mountains, with a very even pressure area on Saturday, mostly north-westerly currents on Sunday, a new light depression on Monday and a front system approaching from North-West and passing over between Tuesday and Wednesday. In the wake of this system, on Thursday a high pressure through will reach the region coming from South-East, with significantly improving conditions.

PARTICULAR PHENOMENON: None. Update Dolomites Snow and Avalanches: 28 April 2011.

FORECAST VALID FOR THE AFTERNOON-EVENING OF SATURDAY 30: At times dull with some partial sunny intervals, esp. in the Prealps, and slightly unsteady with chance of some showers or light showers (40-60%) and occasional thundershowers in the Prealps. At times wide clear-ups in the evening.

FORECAST

SUNDAY 1: Very changeable, mostly clear sky during the night except for some low clouds near the mountains. Rapidly building cumuli from the morning on, with chance (40-60%) of scattered showers or occasional thunderstorms, esp. in the afternoon.

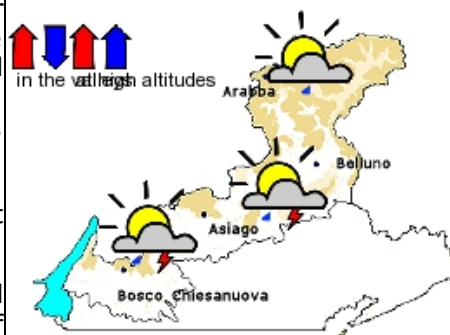
Temperatures: Falling low and rising high temperatures in the valleys. Further rising temperatures at high altitudes. At 2000 m: min 1°C max 7°C; at 3000 m: min -4°C max -2°C.

Winds: Light, shifting at all altitudes. 1-10 km/h at 2000 m, 5-15 km/h at 3000 m.

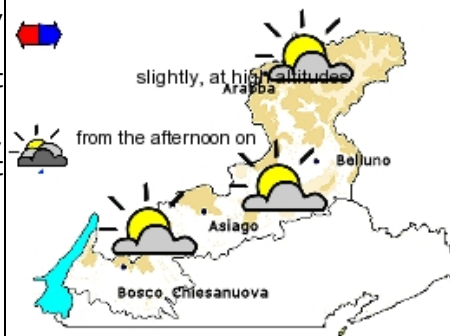
MONDAY 2: Changeable during the night and in the morning, scattered clouds among sunny intervals. From the afternoon on, not only forming of cumuli but also medium-high south-westerly cloudiness, thus less changeable weather than usual and chance (30-50%) of scattered, intermittent showers and light rainshowers. Mostly broken or overcast sky in the evening.

Temperatures: Steady or slightly rising temperatures at high altitudes. At 2000 m: min 2°C max 8°C; at 3000 m: min -3°C max -1°C.

Winds: Light, shifting in the valleys. Generally light, at most moderate, south-westerly at higher altitudes. 1-10 km/h at 2000 m, 15-20 km/h at 3000 m.

TREND

TUESDAY 3: During the night and in the morning cloudy and some scattered showers. Partially easing cloudiness from the afternoon-evening on with chance of at times wide clear-ups. Further slightly rising temperatures, esp. at high altitudes.

WEDNESDAY 4: Changeable, at times unsteady. Chance of showers or thunderstorms, significantly improving conditions in the evening. Sharp falling temperatures, esp. at high altitudes. Forecaster: R.M.
